ALL STAR CAST OF SEATTLE TALENT SET TO JOIN OWUOR ARUNGA FOR BLACK FRIDAY CONCERT AT LANGSTON HUGHES PERFORMING ARTS INSTITUTE

Seattle, WA - An all star cast of Seattle talent, including [Josephine Howell](#), fresh back from performing at American Music Awards with Macklemore will join [Owuor Arunga](#) (Macklemore & Ryan Lewis, The Physics) at Black Friday Concert. Other featured artists are [Black Stax](#), [Otieno Terry](#), [Adra Boo](#), Dadabass, Yirim Seck, Marissa Garrett, and Olu Damar. The concert is part of the Africatown-Central District Winter Arts & Soul Fest and will be held at the historic Langston Hughes Performing Arts Institute on Friday November 27, 2015, with doors opening at 6:30pm. Owuor Arunga is a world renowned trumpet player. As the Musical Director of the Grammy Award-winning hip hop duo Macklemore and Ryan Lewis, Owuor has sold 27 million records. His work has also appeared on Billboards list of five biggest hip hop songs of all time. Owuor has performed on the largest stages in the world, with artists such as: Madonna, Lil Jon, Jennifer Hudson, The Heavy, and Sauti Sol just to name a few. He has been featured on shows including Ellen Degeneres, Saturday Night Live, American Music Awards and many more. He is also a Producer for season 2 and 3 of Coke Studio Africa.
